The time-intensive nature of Navajo weaving will be evident when visitors view Sarah Paul Begay's 10 by 13 foot weaving titled "Navajo Universe." Woven at Garland's Navajo Rugs in Sedona, it is composed of fine threads in intricate detail that took four years to complete - one year for the wool dyeing process and three years to weave.

Symbols and motifs in Navajo weaving | Canyon Road Arts A design element that appeared in Navajo weaving from the late 19th century and continued until the late 1930s is the Navajo "whirling logs." This design is recognized by Anglos as a swastika and caused great controversy in the late 1930s. Navajo - Wikipedia Cheap blankets were imported, so Navajo weavers shifted their focus to weaving rugs for an increasingly non-Native audience. Rail service also brought in Germantown wool from Philadelphia, commercially dyed wool which greatly expanded the weavers' color palettes.
